#### **Eligibility**

The eligibility criteria:

- Eligible applicants include:
    - Nonprofits with 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status that serve Broward County
    - City or County Agencies with projects that demonstrate charitable intent in Broward County
  - If applicable, organizations must have submitted required evaluation reports for all prior grants from the Foundation
  - Current grantees must be in compliance with the terms of those awards to be considered

#### **One-year Grant Information**

One-year grants will follow a payment schedule outlined in the grant agreement.

- Grant range is up to \$100,000
- After the completion of a successful one year grant, if the project has gained a satisfactory level of traction and is moving the needle on the issue, the Foundation may consider your organization for either continual funding of the same project or a future multi-year grant for that project, if requested
- Report progress through mid-year and final report
- Attend mandatory peer learning sessions

#### **Multi-year Grant Information**

*(IMPORTANT: Only available for BFit, Economic Independence, Dignity in Aging, Animal Welfare, ECO Broward, and Youth WORK)*

The Foundation will consider a multi-year grant for up to three years for projects that demonstrate **BIG** and **Bold** impact on this issue. Multi-year grants will follow a payment schedule outlined in the grant agreement and failure to meet project outcomes stipulated for each year may forfeit future disbursements during the multi-year grant period.

---

**Organizations considering the multi-year grant option must:**

- Demonstrate past successful implementation of multi-year grants
- Demonstrate capacity and ability to implement the grant applied for
- Articulate the **BIG** and **Bold** impact the multi-year grant will have
  - Multi-year grant applications must demonstrate that they will accomplish more and achieve greater impact than three successive one-year grants would for the same project. The project must demonstrate impact on enhancing and/or creating lasting systems or infrastructure to impact the outcome

In the **PhilNet™** application, under the “Section C: Project Implementation” tab, indicate your intent to apply for a multi-year grant followed by how the project will address the outcome(s) and a year-by-year detailed implementation plan.

- Attachments to the application
    - Project Timeline must be completed based on the number of years requested with all activities planned and deliverables
    - Budget Bundle – a multi-year budget bundle must be completed and attached. To request a multi-year budget bundle, please email Angelica Rosas at [arosas@cfbroward.org](mailto:arosas@cfbroward.org)
  - Grant range is up to \$100,000 per year
  - Report progress through mid-year and final reports
  - Attend mandatory peer learning sessions
